

Dress Code and Consequences

- Shirts/Sweatshirts/Sweaters: Collared shirts, t-shirts, sweatshirts, or sweaters of solid white, light blue, navy, gold or gray. Holy Cross School logo apparel is acceptable.
- Pants/Shorts/Capri Pants: Jeans or dress pants of khaki, navy or black. Jeans should be newer looking without holes, appropriate length.
(max. 5" above mid-knee)
- Skirts/Jumpers: Jean or twill khaki, navy or black.
(max. 3" above mid-knee)
- **Mass Days:** Mass day is important to Catholic Schools. We request you dress respectfully on this day.
 - **No blue jeans, shorts or athletic team apparel shirts. No flip flops.**
- Dress code applies to gym clothing also.
- The following clothing items are always inappropriate, including for field trips and non-dress code days: camouflage clothing, clothing with inappropriate logos and/or pictures, tank tops/muscle shirts and sleeveless dresses.
- Student's undergarments must remain covered at all times (ie: no low rider pants).

Consequences for dress code violation:

1. Every effort will be made to alter apparel at school in order to comply with the dress code. (ie: student may wear shirt inside out, student may wear clothing provided by the school)
2. A note shall be sent home, to be signed by a parent/guardian, to inform them of the violation.
3. Signed note will be returned the following school day. If not returned, a phone call will be made to insure parent notification.

4. Continued violation of school dress code will necessitate a parent and student meeting with the principal.
